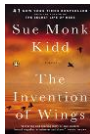

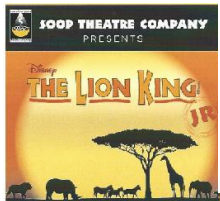

PHILANTHROPIC EVENTS. . .

The Junior League Provisional Project **Pass It On Pelham** held its first drop-off at The Manor Club on Saturday, February 4th from 9am to 12:30pm. It was a very successful event with arts and crafts for the children and musical entertainment. JLP members are invited once a month to drop off gently worn baby and children's clothing for ages up to 16 years old. The JLP is renting an upstairs room at TMC to store the clothing, where it is sorted and then distributed to local community organizations in Westchester and the Bronx. It is a great example of neighbor helping neighbor and TMC is proud to host the monthly drop off.

TMC hosted a **Hearts and Homes for Refugees (HHR)** event on the evening of Sunday, January 29th. HHR is a non-profit group of volunteers based in Pelham assisting in the resettlement of a Syrian family of 6 in Pelham. The meeting at TMC included about 120 people including local Pelham organizations and volunteers, Arabic interpreters, school officials, members of the Westchester Muslim community, and area medical personnel. High school students played games and made scrapbooks during the meeting with the four Syrian children who include two in middle school, 1 in elementary school and 1 preschooler. TMC was happy to host this community event.
